Established by Abu Dhabi Department of Economic Development (ADDED), the Abu Dhabi Business Centre is a one-stop shop that provides various services to investors and businessmen such as licensing and business information services, permits for business, business consulting services and all the necessary support in order to enhance doing business in the emirate.

The center aims to facilitate completing all commercial licenses by electronically connecting 42 government and Simi-government entities,



which will limit the business relationship only between the investing client and the Centre.

The center works to enhance the rankings of the Emirate of Abu Dhabi in the competitiveness reports through developing the investment environment by creating a working system that simplify, facilitate and develop the necessary procedures to obtain business licenses in the emirate, which encourages businessmen and investors to take Abu Dhabi as a destination to start and develop their business activities.

Enhancing the competitiveness Of Abu Dhabi: The Competitiveness Office Of Abu Dhabi (COAD)

The Competitiveness office of Abu Dhabi (COAD) was established by the Department of Economic Development, following the goals of Abu Dhabi's Economic Vision 2030.

The office aims to enhance the competitiveness thinking and commitment of Abu Dhabi's people and enterprises, and helps to create a business environment conducive to innovation and productivity, which encourages investment and the success of business projects in the emirate.

COAD also implements initiatives related to competitiveness, and coordinates with a number of competitiveness analysis and study centers around the world, such as the World Economic Forum (WEF); Institute of Management Development (IMD); and the World Bank.


